*Options for bowling pins are endless; try old plastic bottles, empty containers, cardboard boxes, or plastic cups! These objects can be painted with white with red stripes, at the top, to more closely resemble bowling pins!

Pro Tips

Add auditory feedback by filling the 'bowling pins' with materials that will make noise when knocked over. Try dried rice, jingle bells, or dried beans.

Make it a math activity by counting the pins that fell over and exploring concepts like more than and less than.
